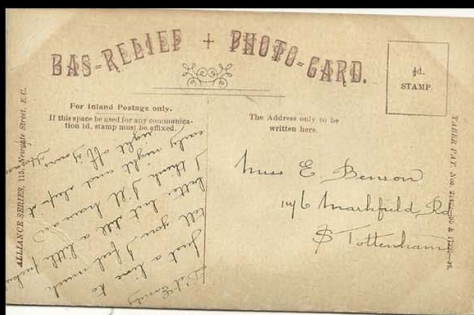


1905 bas relief postcard of Sing Loh from England -an extremely rare find

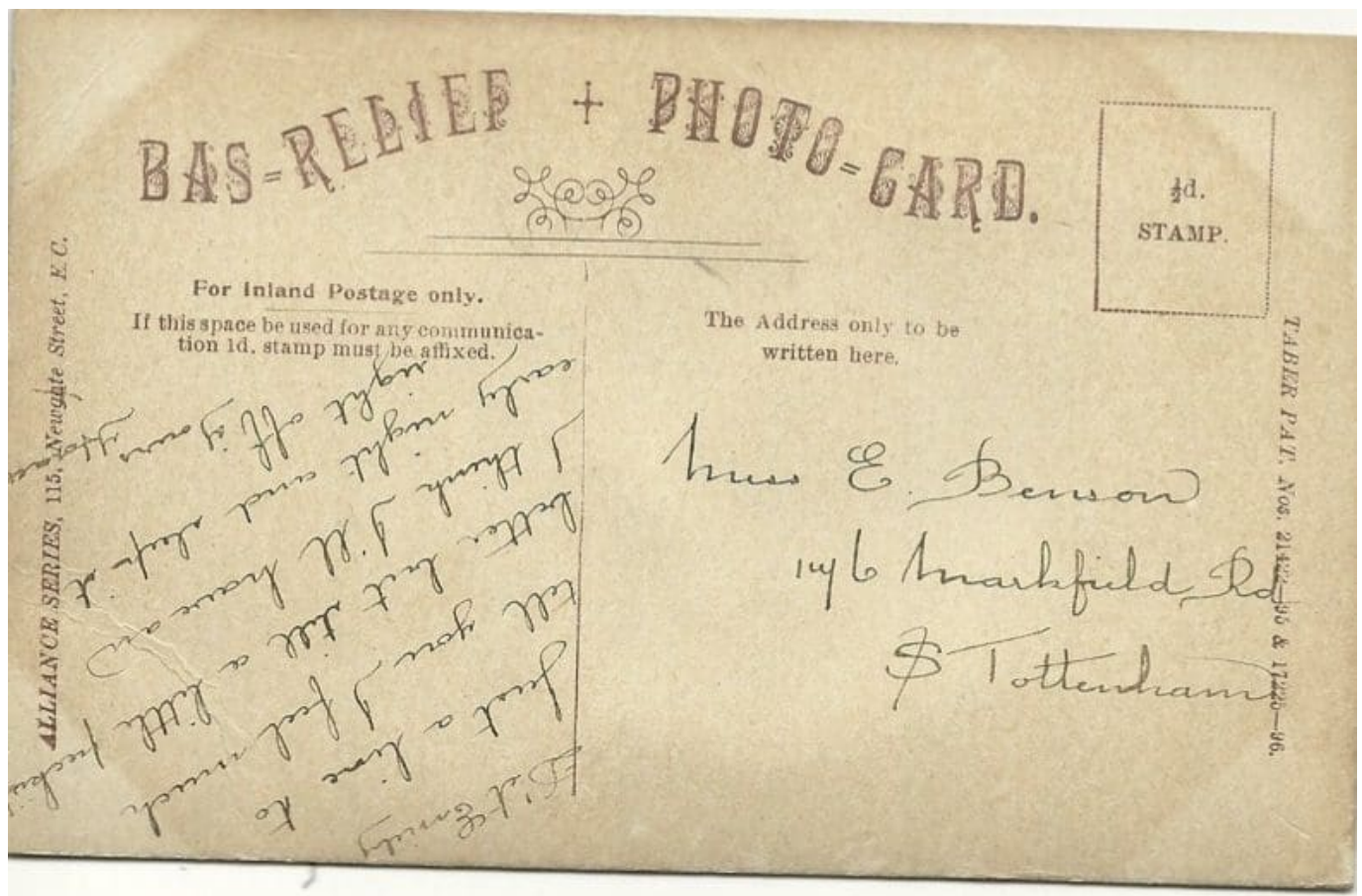

"Alliance Ltd 1902. Publishers 115 Newgate Street London EC. A firm formed to produce bas-relief cards, a type invented by Freeman Augustus Taber of San Francisco. (Taber Bas- Relief Photographic Co) The Alliance output included, Real Photos of Actors, actresses, horses, Jockeys and views of the river Thames. The firm was closely related with A G Scopes & Co

which shared the patent for the procrss registered in 1908. “P

London, and after c.1917 at 4 Lauderdale Buildings London EC.
