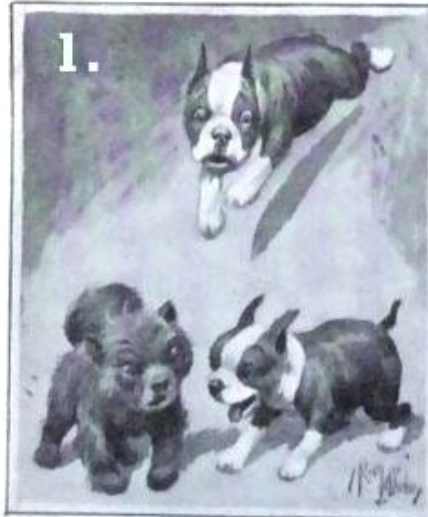

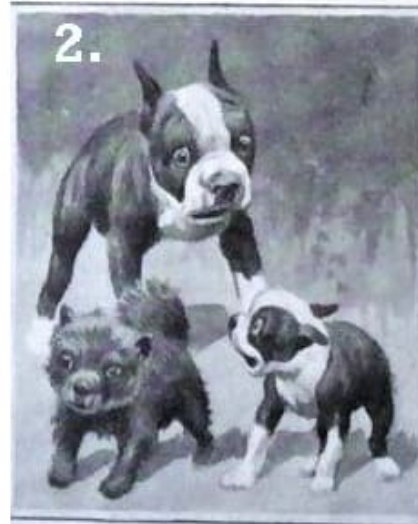

Mr. and Mrs. Beane circa 1925

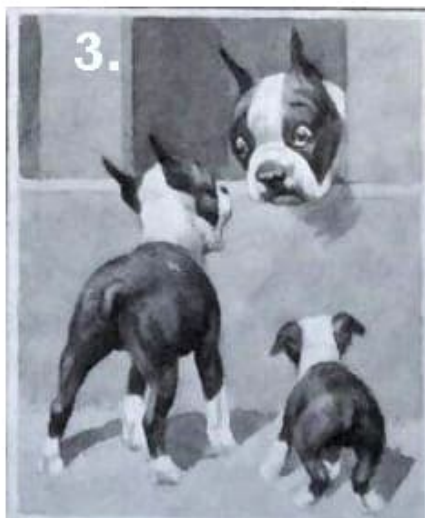

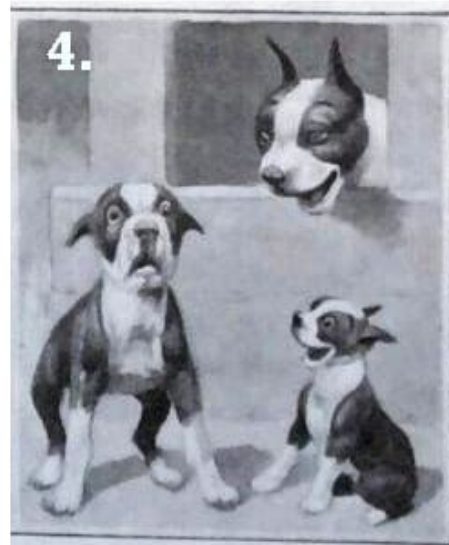
"Buster, Come Here at Once! I Simply Will Not Have You Play With Every Chance Puppy That Comes Along
