Eight others were given long prison sentences.

The trial, lasting 15 days, disclosed that directors of the school held intoxicated revelries with students and assumed the attitude of medieval potentates, forcing girl students to dance and sing before them.

The specific crime for which sentences were passed was an assault upon a girl communist student.



PRIDE OF OWNERSHIP

Once you own a Chow-chow, you will never buy another breed. They are very long lived — only maturing between the ages of four and five years. Their usual span of existence is 17-18 years.

The Chow-chow has many characteristics not shared by other members of the canine world.

Firstly, the Polar bear and the Chow are the only four-footed animals with a black tongue. Frequently when out with one or other of our pets people ask whether they have been injected with blue for billary.

Secondly, their back legs are remarkable for their double-jointedness, and their lack of hock. Their stifles have to be very stiff—this gives them a mineing gait when seen from the rear and the prowl of a lion from the front.

Thirdly, the scowl. This is caused through the light and dark shades in the furrows on the fur-letween the eyes. The hercer the scowl, the more "chow-y" they look.

Their coats are beautiful — very dense and thick. The red chow is often mistaken for a lion, and natives scatter on sight. They stand about 24 inches, and their coat makes them look very much larger. They are not voracious eaters, and are inclined to be finicky. With children the Chow is in its element, as it loves to comp and play. A one-man dog, it loves and obeys only the family to which it belongs.

You can get Chow-chows in red, blue, black and cream, but they must be whole-coloured. The red Chow has light shadings bordering on white at the tail and under the chest usually. They are very clean dogs, requiring practically training in this respect.

A Chow only barks when it is essential to do so.
