The Chow Chow's unique pendulum swing is as important as the blue tongue and "oriental" scowl. The overall balance of correct front and rear angles results in full extension producing the characteristic swinging gait.

Yet, internationally this gait, a historic hallmark of Chow Chow breed type, is not found in the majority of today's Chow Chows. Out of very deep concern, the Chow Chow Club Inc is pleased to present this video, compiled by breed mentors/judges, with the intention of guiding fellow judges in their evaluation.
