SANDRAS NOTES: I am assuming after much searching and not finding evidence of a 1942 National Chow Specialty there may not have been one at all. The United States entered World War II on December 7, 1941 and all the country's attention was focused on defense.

Interestingly enough, The Westminster Kennel Club show went on as usual. From the WKC website "**1941 and 1942** – Proceeds from these shows are donated to the American Red Cross. In 1943 and 1944, proceeds go to the benefit of Dogs for Defense. In 1945, the National War Fund is the recipient of the proceeds. "

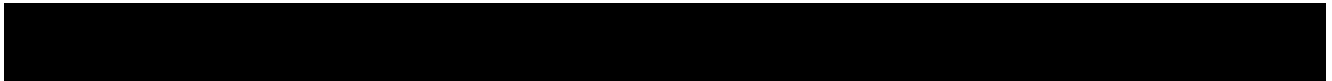

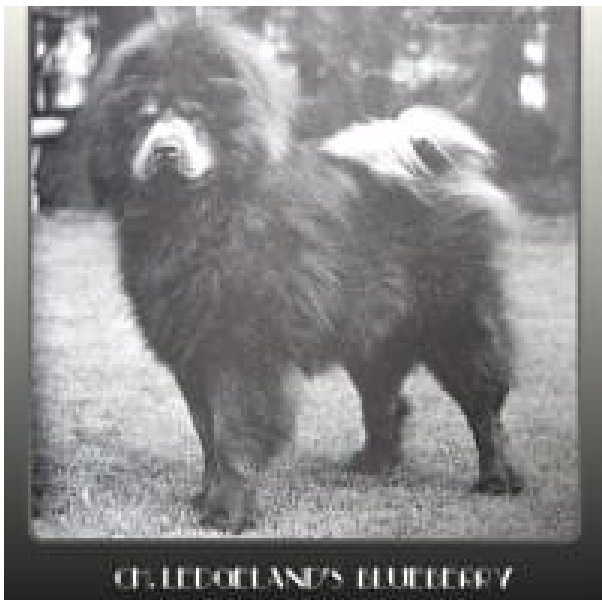

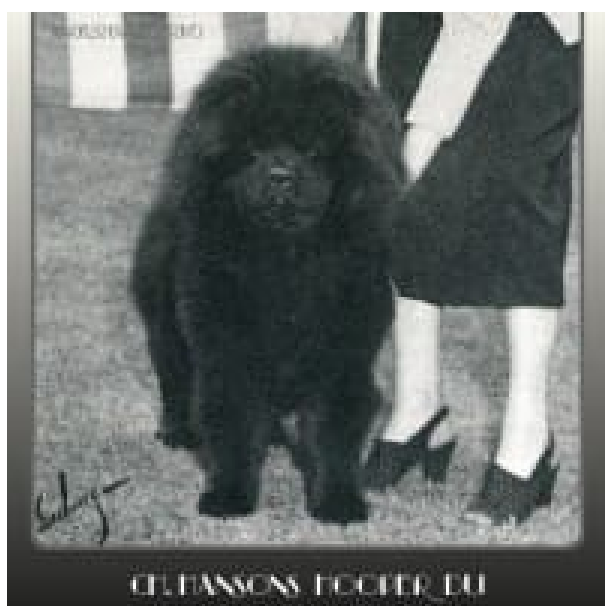
