On the reverse of the picture:-

A black tongue is essential, but it is not wise to destroy puppies with light-coloured tongues, as they often get darker as the puppies grow older.

The smooth variety are even less trouble.

They are a breed that will take a quantity of exercise,

and are better for it, as exercise has a tendency to

ensure good, straight fore legs, and short, well-knit

feet, which are essential in the prize CHOW CHOW

as weak hindquarters of straight stifles are objectionable

although not uncommon in the breed.
