It was once again our pleasure to visit the famous "Rochow" Kennel, where the inmates are very happy, full of character, devoid of nervousness, and very tractable. We will not dwell upon the kennels themselves, for we leave these to visitors, who are always welcome at all times, but from the above description of the dogs it is obvious that without pleasant surroundings and individual attention, this would not be possible.

CH. ROCHOW DRAGON, born 3/10/28, is too well-known to describe, whilst his bench record is phenomenal. He has won 35 challenge certificates! He is also an illustrious stallion, having sired four champions, namely, Rochow Diadem (possessing 12 challenge certificates), Rochow Diaphenia, Hussar of Chung King and Niclos Marksman, besides the Int. Ch. Rochow

Brigadier, and that well-known bitch, Rochow Guenevia. He has the distinction of having sired the dam of Ch. Choonam Hung Kwong, whom he has beaten on three different occasions—every time they have met. His fee is £8 8s. to approved bitches only. ROCHOW ADJUTANT, a self-red dog of 2 years of age, son of Ch. Choonam Toto. He has won two challenge certificates, at Birmingham, 1934, and Metro. and Essex this year, and we do not think it will be long before he owns the title. Mr Rotch hopes always to have a series of litters sired by R. Adjutant, whom he considers one of the finest sires of his time. This we are inclined to believe, judging from the young stock we saw. It is an undisputable fact that he transmits his superlative head properties to his progeny, together with his marvellous bone and feet. Fee £7 7s. to approved

bitches. CH. ROCHOW PATRICIA was nursing a very classy litter, now six weeks old, by the above dog, and what grand puppies they are! It would be most difficult to pick the best. Their head properties are a revelation and they have colossal bone and substance. We fancy their chances in the ring if all goes well.

We also saw two grand home-bred unregistered red bitch puppies by R. Adjutant ex Rochow Duchess, who is a daughter of Ch. R. Dragon. Now six months old, we think they will make their bow to the public in the near future if they are not purchased by some connoisseur of the breed. They would certainly be an acquisition to any kennel, both from a show and breeding point of view. We were also introduced to a nine weeks old red dog puppy by R. Adjutant ex a daughter of Rochow Buckle, who in turn is a son of the late Ch. Chinnery. Many envious eyes will be cast upon him.

An open invitation is extended to all who read this review. Wimbledon is but 3/4 hr. run by car from London and the Rochow Kennel is situated on the South side of a corner of the delightful Wimbledon Common.
