It is about two years since Mrs Montgomery decided to start exhibiting her Chows, although she has owned them much longer. Success has attended her from the start. Nippon, by Red Chu of Robroyston ex Minn Lee of Mira, is a grandly built red dog with a capital head and expression. He has put up a good sequence of wins at open and championship shows. As a stud dog he is a great success. Nippon's stud fee 2 guineas. Tien Long Nahlin is a glorious light red puppy by him out of the winning Choonam Black Emblem. He is four months old and owns a marvellous body with tremendous bone and gives every promise of being a big winner.

Noni is a lovely-headed red dog by Peng Wen of Titiweh, a grandson of Ch. Peng Tse of Amwell which was by Ch. Pusawanli. The splendid characteristics of these two famous sires have been markedly reproduced in this young dog, which in a very short time has won 14 prizes with limited opportunities. Noni's stud fee 3 guineas. Tein-a-Ling Tin by Ben-Ying ex Luci of Shuswop is an exceptionally good blue, possessing a strong short body, big bone, and a particularly good head and expression. She should prove a most valuable brood bitch. Choonam Black Emblem is a worthy black daughter of Choonam Ti Foo Sun ex Choonam Black Duchess, which has proved a valuable asset to the kennel, for not only is she a winner every time shown, but is the dam of some very promising puppies.

Mrs Montgomery keep her Chows purely for the pleasure they give her, but she has a few good specimens for disposal.
