**GOLDEN TERESSA OF GWENDENIA** is a sweet, compact, running red bitch, well coupled up, with splendid coat and bone. Apart from her quality, which is always apparent, her puppies are the most lovable little "Teddy Bears," that ever gladdened the eye. He is by Rochow Trigger ex Lady Chang Koo.

The other dogs include **DRAYRR**, a beautiful, outstanding fawn; well made, well boned, thick-coated og hard to fault, and probably the finest-headed og in the country. He possesses a really wonderful scowl. He is a winner of firsts at championship shows, and has been made many times best in show. He is y Choomam Blue Cloud ex Northwoods Bluebell. **FASCINATION OF GWENDENIA**, a home-bred Smooth red og of promise, firm as a rock, well put together, a atural show dog, is just now proving his capabilities t stud and his owner has plenty of confidence in him. e is by Chango Kwong of G. ex Golden Teresa of G. **MRS. ROSALIND STIFFS PRIZE-WINNING CHOWS**

**T**HE outstanding feature of all Chows owned by Mrs. Stiff is their excellent temperament and disposition, which is due to the fact that all are house-trained from puppyhood, before entering the show-ring. A typical example of stock owned is illustrated in **SEPHA NOTSMRUF**, which won the certificate at the L.K.A. ch. show at Olympia, in March, 1939, under Mrs. M. L. Cliff and reserve for that honour at Brighton, Harrogate, Manchester, and the Kennel Club shows. She is home-bred by Rukri Mt Chung, which is by Ch. Choomam To To out of Aehvale Shang Ti, which is by Ashvale Wu Ling, and scores heavily in head and expression and owns an exceptionally dark eye. She is compact and well boned, and has the best of legs and feet and quarters. She is now in her prime and can hold her own in any company. Her beautiful Chow coat and small, well-placed ears, and deep muzzle, will always command attention.

Other good specimens owned by Mrs. Stiff include **SNOW SLOW**, nearly white, a rare-bodied one, bred right down to his toes. His head and expression are very pleasing. He has a perfect mouth and the darkest of eyes. He is placed at stud at the low fee of two guineas. **IRINA** and **NECKA** are well worthy of special mention. There is also a very promising black bitch, but owing to serious illness and the cancellation of shows she has not yet been exhibited.

Mrs. Stiff, who is a very keen judge of the breed, usually has young stock for sale.



## GREAT WESTWOOD HERCULES.

**T**HE head study is of **GREAT WESTWOOD HERCULES**, born July 11th, 1938. He is by Ch. Trumpeter of Chungking out of Husar Tu of Chungking. This handsome dog is the winner of many first prizes.

The other photograph shows **GREAT WESTWOOD VALENTINE**, a smooth. This home-bred eight-months-old puppy is by Great Westwood Cupid, a smooth dog of merit, out of the smooth bitch, Suzette of the Follies, and was one of a litter of smooths.

Amongst the other Chows in this extensive and successful kennel is **SABU**, the well-known black dog, born in November, 1938. He is by Ch. You Si out of Loo Choo of Jehol, and is now placed at stud at the fee of five guineas.

Mrs. Barratt has, in spite of the difficulties war-time travel imposes on activities, exhibited extensively and fearlessly at breed club shows and in varieties whenever opportunity permitted. These war-time shows have made her black bitch, **GREAT WESTWOOD BLACK PANSY**, familiar to many in the South and the Midlands. She is by Son o' Sam out of Peony of Chungking, and is thus a granddaughter of Ch. Roehow Adjutant. She is the winner of many firsts and best in show; her wins at championship shows prior to the outbreak of war secured her entry in the Stud Book, 819 V.V.

**T**HE photograph shows **RAPHAEL OF PADUA**, a red dog of merit by Ch. Choomam Hung Kwong out of Choomam Red Willow. This well-built dog has a good head, ample bone, compact body and coat of excellent texture. He has taken firsts at many shows. This dog is at stud to approved bitches, and inquiries as to terms should be addressed to Mrs. Woodward.
