THE first shining rapture of the original enthusiasm is so apt to become dim as the span of the years go by, but although Miss Baker's Chow stud is one of the oldest in the fancy, she herself has never known the fog of lethargy, and her kennel has never fallen from the high standard which made the Moorwoods effective emphases from the very beginning.
