THE photograph shows the owner, Mrs. Enid Mann, with her home-bred black dog, RAS KOHL of HO-PING, at seven months. He is a son of Ch. Rochow Adjutant and a litter brother to Rochow Solario. He is a winner of many firsts and best in breed. On the right is Estelle of HO-PING (red) at one year. She is a winner and mother of winners.

Mrs. Mann also has at stud, CORONAG of HO-PING, a red son of Ch. Rochow Adjutant, a first-prize winner; also PE T'SING of HO-PING, another red, a son of Ransom of Padua. He is a promising young dog who has already sired an outstanding puppy in Shah Kohl of HO-PING.

Mrs. Mann has at present 10 Chows in her kennel, an Afghan and a Scottie.

All her dogs are house-trained, and disposition is given a special attention. Blacks are a feature in this kennel—really good blacks, outstandingly heavily boned.

Among the winners this kennel has produced are: Rochow Solario, Rochow Trigger, Callisto (a bitch which won at Cruft's), Tiang of Chi Fu, and Pretty Polly of Graveney. The last two were winners of firsts at Cruft's in 1933. Puppies are usually for sale.

The kennels are always open for inspection, and visitors are warmly welcomed.

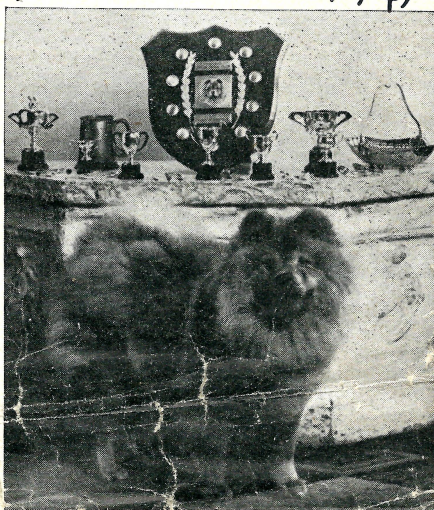
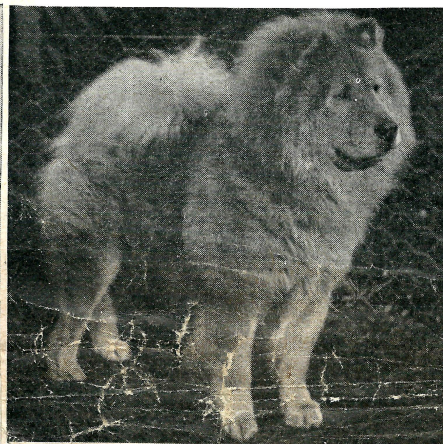
