Our Cover

Our cover this month shows the Chow Chow, Ebony Idol of Glenn Cove, owned by the Glenn Cove Kennels, of Northbrook, Illinois. This dog is without a doubt one of America's outstanding Chows. It would be useless to describe his head properties as the picture shows what a stunning dog he is. Idol weighs fifty-five pounds, has a beautiful barrel-shaped body with immense spring of rib and is extremely short in back. As Miss Dietrich says:

"He stands on four of the straightest heaviest boned legs one could desire and his jet black coat is phenomenal.

"Idol has an exceptionally fine disposition and transmits this property to his offspring. He is the son of the famous Little Boy Blue, and if bred to black or blue females his progeny is jet black or pale blue puppies, always without the undesirable cast

of other shades. On several occasions a pure cream has appeared."

Red Shay of Glenn Cove, whose picture appeared in the November issue of THE DOG NEWS, was sired by Ebony Idol out of Black Charm of Glenn Cove.

Fine Chow Goes to California

Ch. Yuan Chu of El Cher has been sold by the El Cher Kennels, of Ridgewood, New Jersey, to Mr. and Mrs. Frank Isbell, of Van Nuys, California. These fanciers made a special trip East to find a fine Chow and in consequence the sale was consummated at a record figure—perhaps the highest ever paid for an American bred Chow.

Yuan Chu, or Sonny, as he is called, now heads the Western Kennel.

To old time baseball fans this name of Isbell will be familiar, as Frank

Isbell is the President and owner of the Wichita Falls Baseball Club, and a former star player on the Chicago White Sox.

Ch. Yuan Chu is considered one of the best Chows of the younger generation. He was sired by Ch. Ledge-lands Sancho ex Ch. Tuthy Anky of El Cher. He has had an unexcelled show career, beginning in February, 1926, at Hartford, Connecticut. His winning points were gained at Hartford, Pittsburgh, Canton, Cambridge, Scranton, Buffalo, and Rochester. His show career lasted two months and two weeks and he was exactly eighteen months of age when he became a Champion. His dam, Tuthy Anky, went right along with her offspring and finished her Championship a few days later at Devon.

He will be placed at public stud in the West and will no doubt do his share to improve the breed on the Coast.
